# Tele-psychiatry and tele-behavioral health interactive technologies

#### **Computerized Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT)**

- CBT Used to reduce dependence on medications
- Computerized CBT Improved depression, negative attributional style, work and social adjustment

#### **Smart Pill Bottles and Dispensing hardware/software**

- Rings or alerts client of time to take medications
- Notifies care givers for immediate intervention
