Four Word Build Activity

Goal:

Identify key values, goals, or themes central to a group or team's mission or objective.

Activity Description:

- 1. Define your guiding question. For instance, "what are our team's main guiding values?"
- 2. Break out into pairs and each pair identifies four words that are essential to the question at hand. For example, "kindness, change, evidence, and youth-driven."
- 3. Each pair partners with another pair and, together, they identify four words that are essential to the question at hand. Try to reach a consensus on the four words.
- 4. Each group of four partners with another group of four to become a group of 8. This process repeats until the entire group is working together to identify their four words that are essential. If the group is very large, the last 2 or 3 large groups could offer their lists to a facilitator, and a facilitator guides the full group through the process of identifying the final four words.
- 5. Once your team reaches a consensus, place those four words in areas where the full group can see them frequently throughout the rest of their work together.
