Thresholds provides healthcare, housing, and hope for more than 15,000 people with mental illnesses and substance use disorders in Illinois. Thresholds has been part of Healthy Chicago since 2015.


Promote evidence-based integration of primary and behavioral healthcare.

Thresholds opened three co-located integrated care clinics in partnership with Heartland Health Center, Aunt Martha's, and Howard Brown Health to provide primary and psychiatric care for 750+patients.

We have purchased software to share data between electronic health records systems, boosting the quality of care and our ability to track and research outcomes.

Strengthen and promote programs that provide intensive case management for people leaving jail or prison.

Thresholds provides comprehensive behavioral health services to people who are released from Cook County jail. Last year, the Thresholds Justice Program served 87 people leaving jail, and only 8% of those clients were later rearrested.
