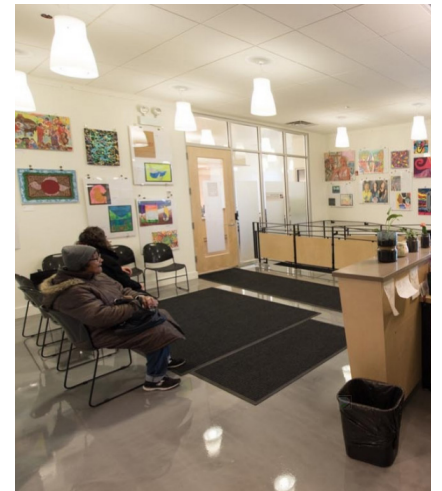

Thresholds provides healthcare, housing, and hope for more than 15,000 people with mental illnesses and substance use disorders in Illinois. Thresholds has been part of Healthy Chicago since 2015.

### **Promote evidence-based integration of primary and behavioral healthcare.**

Thresholds opened three co-located integrated care clinics in partnership with Heartland Health Center, Aunt Martha's, and Howard Brown Health to provide primary and psychiatric care for 750+ patients.

We have purchased software to share data between electronic health records systems, boosting the quality of care and our ability to track and research outcomes.



### **Strengthen and promote programs that provide intensive case management for people leaving jail or prison.**

Thresholds provides comprehensive behavioral health services to people who are released from Cook County jail. Last year, the Thresholds Justice Program served 87 people leaving jail, and only 8% of those clients were later rearrested.
